Commissioner Watts called the meeting to order at 5:45 PM.

Request to Restore Porch and Wooden Cross-Hatch Windows

Commissioner Watts noted that the applicants, Vanda and Kevin Doyle were present and he asked them to discuss their request.

Kevin Doyle said that the request before the commission is to restore the wooden cross-hatch windows as they originally existed and to restore the porch to its original configuration as shown in photos from the Windsor Historical Society.

Commissioner Watts noted that he liked the proposal as the home would be restored to its original condition.
