Based on the net taxable Grand List of October 1, 2016 as adjusted by the Board of Assessment Appeals, a mill rate of 32.85 mills for real estate and personal property and a mill rate of 32.00 mills for motor vehicles, with adjustments for exemptions for volunteer firefighters, senior tax relief, pro rata assessor's addition, and a reserve for uncollectible taxes, will provide a net current tax levy of \$86,639,660 for real estate and personal property and a motor vehicle levy of \$5,919,300. To this \$1,144,100 has been added for prior year tax collections, interest and penalties, and \$570,000 for additional taxes to be collected under CGS §12-71b.
