Please note the following regarding Section 21 – CHRO Contract Compliance Regulations:

The Town would like to reiterate that although the entire contract is state-funded and a minimum of 25% of the Contract is required to be awarded to MBE, SBE and/or DBE Subcontractors holding certification from DAS, CHRO understands that a sole source contractor may not be able to achieve the set aside, but MUST demonstrate good faith effort to meet that 25% set-aside goal. The selected Contractor must adequately describe and detail their good faith effort in the Affirmative Action or Set Aside Plan they file with CHRO.

Good faith effort may involve the use of MBE, SBE and/or DBE Subcontractors for most, if not all, of the other work beyond the milling, paving and curbing operations.
