APPROVED MINUTES

In accordance with Gov. Lamont's Executive Order No7B, this meeting was held via Zoom teleconferencing.

Item #4. Fire & EMS Additions & Renovations Design Project - 9912

Motion: Commissioner Rusty Peck moves to approve payment on Invoice #18009.02-19 to Kaestle Boos Assoc. for Construction Administrative Services thru March 30, 2021 at the Fire & EMS Stations Additions & Renovations Design project Phase #3 in the amount of \$9,825.19. Seconded by Commissioner Gary Johnson.

Motion: Commissioner Jim Bennett moves to approve payment on Invoice #2002207 Requisition 07 dated March 31, 2021 to PAC Group LLC for work performed at the Fire & EMS Stations Additions & Renovations Design project in the amount of \$897,038.41. Seconded by Commissioner Rusty Peck.

Jim Russo gave a quick look ahead for this project as follows. PCO #49 has been pulled from this project. Adding PCO #50, which is to add additional tile in the 2 main bathrooms. The storm lights are still be installed, they should be finished by the end of the week. The framing of the walls is substantially done. The MEPS overhead roughing is ongoing. Sheet rocking of the walls is up and taping of phase 2 is completed. Installing the front window should be completed this

week. Ceiling grid will start next week. Bathroom tiling will be done next week. The remainder of the CMU walls are complete. Installing the trench drains is on schedule. Installing radiant heat tubing starting next week. Regarding the ASI Log the drawing for the roof edge clarification is closed. Column covers in the watch room, the drawings were issued in which there may be some additional cost there. The light fixtures in WP 2 controls have no additional cost there. The condensate drains in the shared mechanical room should be no additional coast but waiting on PAC Group for that.

The Commission is all in agreement. So noted.

Item #5. Sage Park Middle School Roof Construction Design Project – 9506

Whit stated that stated he received 6 bids for this project. The low bidder was Silktown Roofing. We used them for the roofing project on Addison Rd and he recommends that we use them for this project. They have done other projects in Town as well. Whit stated he will go the Town Council for funding.

Motion: Commissioner Gary Johnson moves to award the Sage Park Middle School Roof Construction project to Silktown Roofing for \$1,432,000.00. Seconded by Commissioner Rusty Peck.

<u>Item #6. Sage Park Middle School Alternative Energy & HVAC Efficiency Upgrade Project</u> – 9519

Whit stated that the Board of Education would like to would like to add natural gas to the roof top units that they are replacing. He would like to put this on hold. Adding the heat exchanges to the roof top units almost doubles in weight and the architects Salamone & Associates are checking the existing roof bindings if it can support the additional weight. Also, checking the existing gas meter, to see if it is large enough for this and the cost of the units. He would like to table the Invoice from Action Air Systems, Inc. at this time for review. The Commission agrees. Whit stated that Building Material Inspection is needed at this project and asks the Commission to approve this estimate as "NOT TO EXCEED" the amount. May not even use this but just in case it is needed.
