Item #4. Fire & EMS Additions & Renovations Design Project - 9912

Motion: Commissioner Jim Bennett moves to approve Application for Payment on Invoice # 12002212, Requisition #12, dated 8/31/2021, to the PAC Group LLC for work performed at the Fire & EMS Stations Additions & Renovations project in the amount of \$421,016.00. Motion: Commissioner Lee Alford moves to accept O & G's Proposal, dated 9/17/2021, to fix the structural issue at the wall along the Wood Shop at the Sage Park Middle School Roof Project in the amount of \$22,398.00. Seconded by Voting Alternate George Roebelen.
