Item #1 - Oliver Ellsworth School Humidity Mitigation Design – 9574 CIP FY2024

Dave Madigan came in from vanZelm Heywood & Shadford, Inc. to give an update on the design and respond to the questions and concerns to the public regarding the envelope of the building. The negative pressure and the faults of the existing equipment or the non-functionality of the existing equipment. Dave Madigan spoke about addressing the clauses of the moisture problem at Oliver Ellsworth School. He also talk about the status and where do we go from here step by step. He also mention that some of the information might be a little repetitive. No one from the public attended the meeting.

<u>Item #2 - Sage Park Middle School Slab Moisture Mitigation Design – 9567 CIP FY2023</u>

Sent out an email to the Commission to show we have done some excavation to try find the footing drains we thought it might be out there. What we've discover there is no footing drains on the 3 areas that we excavated. The areas we excavated were around the gym they didn't have footing drains, but the other surprising thing there was no moisture. I was dealing with DPW for digging and engineering to help me evaluate the footing drains. At this point they advise to come back in the spring. We need to find the source of the water. Marco recommended to go back to Hoffman and let them know what we found. Commissioner Jim Bennett ask question, what's the current condition side to the school right now. Carlos Rosario mention water came up through the tiles through the summer break. When Carlos see the water problem maybe that's a good time to come out and dig. Marco suggested to back to Hoffman at this point and tell them what we found, see if they have other options they recommend with the findings and bring it back with the evaluation.

<u>Item #3 - Sage Park Middle School HVAC Repl & Additions Design Ph. 2&3 – 9519 CIP FY2022</u> They designing new report there.

Item# 4 - Sage Park MS HVAC Repl & Additions Phase 2&3 Combined Const-9542 CIP FY2023 We did the punch list for phase 2 and phase 3. The general contractor has those lists and they are in the process of making all the corrections. For Sage Park Phase 2 we are closing out that job, also for the rest of this month in next (2) weeks we establish a substantial completion date for both phase 2 and 3.

<u>Item# 5 – Sage Park MS HVAC Repl & Additions Phase 3 Construction – 9542 CIP FY2023</u>
Action air has 2 change orders which were approved. They asked whether they could built for retainage and do the change orders accordingly so it would not hold up the retainers. Marco Aglieco advise to go ahead and bill for retainage.

<u>Item#6 – LP Wilson Community Center HVAC Improvements Design Ph. 2– 9551 CIP FY2023</u>
We are waiting for specifications and to get the ad from the engineer. Then it will go out for bid within the next two weeks.

<u>Item#7 - LP Wilson HVAC Replacements & Additions Ph. 1 Construction - 9551 CIP FY2023</u>

Per Jim Russo, they are still working on site second shift. They still a lot of loose ends to finish up and right now we are going for fire alarm and inspection in February 19th with Fire Marshall and Building Dept. My understanding is the units have not been started yet, so we are hoping to get that done within 3 to 4 weeks. The asbestos which we encounter in December has been completed.

This change order has been voided.
