**APPROVED MINUTES**

**1) CALL TO ORDER**

The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:20 p.m. by Mayor Trinks.

Present: Mayor Donald Trinks, Deputy Mayor McAuliffe, Councilor James Govoni, Councilor Donald Jepsen, Councilor Rampulla Bress, Councilor Len Walker and Councilor Kenneth Wilkos.

Absent: Councilor Dobler, Councilor Black-Burke

Mayor Trinks read aloud the notice of the public hearing to hear public comment on:

- AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,535,000 FOR COSTS IN CONNECTION WITH IMPROVEMENTS TO SAGE PARK MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETIC FIELDS; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$1,535,000 BONDS AND NOTES TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION.

**2) PUBLIC COMMENT**

Ned Bacigalupo, 89 Farmstead Lane, expressed concerns about the \$1.5 million being spent for soccer fields and feels they are already playable fields. He questioned if money would be returned if the project comes in under budget. He expressed his opinion that the AstroTurf was unnecessary.
