2. Chairperson's remarks – Bruce (2 minutes)
3. Meeting minutes – Bruce (2 minutes): Bob Gange motioned to approve the January minutes and Russell Sills 2<sup>nd</sup>.
4. Updates on commission members, vacancies, and recruitment – Bruce (1 minute): We have two new members- Jeremy Halek and Kereme
5. LPC report – Sarah (1 minute): \$5,300 and the Youth Commission guide in some of the spending, such as the High School project graduation of \$500. The project graduation is still unsure if it will happen this year due to COVID19.

- a) Police Department: N/A
- b) Recreation Services: Planning mode for summer activities, Activity bags are being put together for 90 participants in either the RISE or YIA after school program. Windsor Police will deliver the bags and RISE and YIA staff will follow the police. Staff have assisted with the Social Services Department for the Groceries to Go program. Discord, is a video game server. There are currently 35 gamers. Virtual program links are updated regularly with activities and events. Virtual Jukebox Bingo was a success with 50 families registered, but over 200 actual participants due to family members.
- c) Windsor Public Schools: Teachers are working hard and everyone is learning from the distance learning. They have Wellness Wednesdays. There are some families affected by the COVID19.

- f) Youth Services: April was child abuse month. There were blue pinwheels around town. Several virtual activities are taking place with collaboration with the Recreation department.
