APPROVED MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER

Present: Councilor Lisa Rampulla Bress, Chair, Councilor Nuchette Black-Burke and Councilor Lenworth Walker

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. PUBLIC COMMENT

3. CANDIDATE INTERVIEWS AND REAPPOINTMENTS TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

a) Tyler Cote – Unaffiliated – interested in Wilson/Deerfield Advisory Committee and Housing Code Board of Appeals

Mr. Cote did not attend the meeting.

b) Taariq Jaamal – Unaffiliated – interested in Windsor Housing Authority

The committee met virtually with Mr. Jaamal to discuss his interest in being appointed to the Windsor Housing Authority.

MOVED by Councilor Walker, seconded by Councilor Black-Burke, to appoint Taariq Jaamal as an Unaffiliated member to the Windsor Housing Authority for a five-year term to expire July 31, 2025 or until a successor is appointed (*to replace Rondinone*).

Motion Passed 3-0-0

c) Sherwin LeGendre – Democrat – interested in Human Relations Commission and Conservation Commission

The committee met virtually with Mr. LeGendre regarding his interest in becoming a member on the Human Relations Commission and the Conservation Commission.

MOVED by Councilor Black-Burke, seconded by Councilor Walker, to appoint Sherwin LeGendre as a Democratic Alternate member to the Conservation Commission for a five-year term to expire November 30, 2025 or until a successor is appointed (*to replace Washington*).

Motion Passed 3-0-0

d) Jamie Hodgson – Unaffiliated – interested in Human Relations Commission

The committee met virtually with Mr. Hodgson regarding his interest in becoming a volunteer on the Human Relations Commission.

MOVED by Councilor Black-Burke, seconded by Councilor Bress to appoint Jamie Hodgson as an Unaffiliated Alternate member to the Human Relations Commission for a three-year term to expire May 31, 2021 or until a successor is appointed (*to replace Williams*).

Motion Passed 2-1-0 (Councilor Walker against)

e) Linda Massa – Unaffiliated – interested in Human Relations Commission and Commission on Aging & Persons with Disabilities – APPOINTMENT

Linda Massa did not attend the meeting.

f) Marsha Brown – Unaffiliated Member – Commission on Aging & Persons with Disabilities - REAPPOINTMENT

MOVED by Councilor Black-Burke, seconded by Councilor Walker to reappoint Marsha Brown as an Unaffiliated member to the Commission on Aging & Persons with Disabilities for a three-year term to expire November 8, 2023 or until a successor is appointed.

Motion Passed 3-0-0

g) Charles Jackson – Republican Member – Wilson/Deerfield Advisory Committee - REAPPOINTMENT

MOVED by Councilor Walker, seconded by Councilor Black-Burke to reappoint Charles Jackson as a Republican member to the Wilson/Deerfield Advisory Committee for a three-year term to expire April 30, 2023 or until a successor is appointed.

6. COMMUNICATIONS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS

- Councilor Walker referred to the Town Charter (5.1 subsection D) and asked for an inquiry on whether the filling of Republican vacancies on the Human Relations Commission with Unaffiliated Members violates that subsection.
- Councilor Walker pointed out there may be discrepancies between the Town of Windsor Boards and Commissions list and the vacancies for Boards and Commissions listed on the Town website. The Committee requests they be cross-referenced to ensure the Town Website accurately reflects current Board and Commission vacancies.
- Councilor Black-Burke would like the public to know the Superintendent search is currently taking place. There is a survey on the Windsor Board of Ed website and other opportunities to participate, including on January 13th.
