Ms. Peyton stated that a possible option for a coordinator would be an AmeriCorps Vista. This could be part time and cost approximately \$5,000 for a year, not funded by AmeriCorps Vista. This could assist with the low income and equity portion.

Ms. Yetman attended another meeting about electric school buses. She was able to do some research on Highland Electric and stated that Dattco is interested in electric buses. She is looking to participate in some webinars on electric fleets in the future.

Mr. Slate commented on the topic of AmeriCorps Vista program. He also commented on the net metering initiatives by the League of Conservation Voters.

Mr. Weiner stated that Connecticut has a bill tracker for those interested in environmental and climate bills that are being discussed in the current session.
