

Windsor Senior Center Updated Guidelines

As of May 24, 2021



All guidelines/requirements are subject to change per Governor Lamont.

At this time and until further notice, we will FULLY OPEN the Windsor Senior Center. Members will be required to sign in for each activity, program, and event.

Registering for Senior Center activities is easy and accepted via telephone, walk-in, mail-in, or online!

- **Telephone:** Call 860-285-1992 for all activities that are free of charge
 - **Walk-in or Mail-in Registration:** Complete a registration form and bring it OR mail it with a check payable to: Town of Windsor, 599 Matianuck Avenue, Windsor, CT 06095
 - **Online:** Register at townofwindsorct.com/senior-services - for assistance, feel free to call us at the Senior Center
 - Registration may be limited based on the program
- **Mask Wearing** - All fully vaccinated patrons will no longer be required to wear a mask throughout the town buildings. Dial-A-Ride riders must wear a mask while on the buses. All non-fully vaccinated patrons shall continue to wear masks in accordance with State of CT safety protocols and orders.
- **Proof of COVID-19 vaccination is not required to participate in Windsor Senior Center programs or activities.** Participants should follow the recommendations of the CDC, State of Connecticut, and the Department of Health regarding masks.
- **If you have any of the following symptoms** - fever, cough, and/or shortness of breath, please refrain from attending programs.
- **Check In** - Each participant must sign in upon arrival, every time. Be sure to sign in at the entrance that you use, the Main Entrance or the Senior Center Entrance. Please complete all sections and please print information clearly. You will then be directed to the location of the program/activity you are attending.
- **Drop In at the Center** - YES! Unless pre-registration is required for a program or activity, you are welcome to come in at your leisure, have a cup of coffee during coffee socials, work on a puzzle or craft, play a game, etc., but please remember to sign in and wear your mask if not fully vaccinated.
- **Social Distancing** - Whenever possible, maintain appropriate separation between one another.
- **Hand Sanitizer/Hand Washing** - Hand sanitizer will be located in each space. Participants are encouraged to use the hand sanitizer before entering a room and before participating in an activity
- **Fitness Classes** - Some classes will continue via Zoom and some will continue on-site. Please see the Windsor Senior Center Newsletter for details. All fitness classes require registration in advance.
- **Fitness Center** - Masks will no longer be required by those who have been fully vaccinated. We do require that you sanitize the equipment that you are using before and after each use. Please sanitize your hands prior to using equipment in this space. When hours are extended, we will notify you.
- **Meals/Eating/Drinking** - CRT will not be serving meals at this time. We will continue with home delivered CRT meals weekly. For more information, please refer to our monthly newsletter. You may bring food or drink for yourself. No sharing of food or drink is permitted at this time. There are beverage and snack machines located in the main hallway of LP Wilson. We will not be offering self-service beverage stations at this time (i.e.: coffee bar). Coffee will be served to you during Coffee Socials. Water fountains are still not available for use other than to fill up a water bottle.
