Camp Foxfire offers week-long nature programs for young campers that focus on science, agriculture and environmental education within our 473 acre campus at Northwest Park. We invite you to register for one, two or all three of our unique weekly themed sessions. To accommodate as many children as possible, campers are not permitted to repeat the same theme a second time. Children may only attend a maximum of three weeks at Camp Foxfire. Northwest Park's staff are highly qualified individuals who enjoy working with children. All staff members are certified in First Aid and CPR. Pre K- Kindergarten grade camps have 2 adult leaders with no more than 12 participants. Camper groups are based on the grade your child will **enter in the fall. Pre K and Kindergarten campers must be at least 4 years old by June 1, 2019 and potty trained.**
