IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Do you have an electric or gas shut off notice?

If so, here are the steps we encourage you to follow:

1. Contact the credit department to ask what you need to prevent termination in services.

CNG Credit Dept. 1-973-796-9390
2. Ask about payment plans that you may be eligible for (ex. New Start or personal payment plans)
3. Then contact the Social Service department to see if you qualify for assistance.
