WINDSOR FOOD BANK TEMPORARY RELOCATION BEING PLANNED SOON

At some point in the next several months, the Windsor Food Bank will be relocating to 100 Addison Road as a temporary distribution location for a few months while renovations are made to our current location at the LP Wilson Community Center.

The planned improvements to the Windsor Food Bank will increase capacity for storage of food and create a more efficient space to intake and distribute food.

Registered clients will receive a robo call with specific information when our relocation date is confirmed.

MEDICARE ADVANTAGE OPEN ENROLLMENT

You can make changes to your Medicare Advantage and Medicare drug coverage when certain events happen in your life, like if you move or you lose other coverage.

These chances to make changes are called Special Enrollment Periods.

The types of changes you can make and the timing depend on your life event.

If you have questions or need help making enrollment changes, call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227). TTY users can call 1-877-486-2048.

Starting Jan. 1, 2024, if you sign up for Part A and/or Part B because of an exceptional situation, you'll have 2 months to join a Medicare Advantage Plan (with or without drug coverage) or a Medicare drug plan (Part D). Your coverage will start the first day of the month after the plan gets your request to join.

If you're already in a Medicare Advantage Plan, **Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment Period** runs from January 1-March 31. This is the time you can switch to another Medicare Advantage Plan with or without drug coverage. You can also drop your Medicare Advantage Plan and go back to Original Medicare or join a Medicare drug plan.
