4. Be sure to fill out the application for exemption of Farm Machinery on the back of the form if it pertains to you. Failure to complete this application will result in the loss of the exemption.

New for 2018. Public Act 18-79 was passed by the State Legislature. It states "property that has an original value of no more than \$250 and is ten years or older is exempt from taxation". Therefore, these items do not need to be declared.
