PUT A FREEZE ON WINTER FIRES

Christmas is the peak for candle fires. Almost half of the decoration fires in December are started by candles.

Here are some safety tips to prevent this:

- Use battery-operated flameless candles
- Keep candles at least 12 inches away from anything that burns
- Keep your Christmas tree watered and get rid of the tree right after Christmas or when its dry
- Make sure to keep your tree at least three feet away from heat sources like fireplace or space heaters.
