- 2. Sections 12-41 and 12-42 of the *Connecticut General Statutes* require owners or individuals in possession of any motor vehicle that is not registered with the Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles, to declare such vehicles to the Assessor as taxable Personal Property.
- 3. Any form submitted after November 1<sup>st</sup> will be subject to a 25% late penalty.
- 4. IMPORTANT: This form must be returned even if the vehicle was sold or disposed of. Please note the disposition of the vehicle or other pertinent information on the form, sign it, and <u>RETURN THE FORM</u>. Otherwise, the Assessor must assume that you have taxable personal property and have failed to declare it.
- 5. It is advisable to retain one (1) copy of the form for your records.
