Flu Shot Clinic

The Windsor Health Department will be holding a walk-in Flu Shot Clinic in conjunction with the Senior Health and Wellness Fair on Thursday, October 6th from 8:30am – 12:00noon.



Persons 18yo+ are eligible to receive a flu shot and those 65yo+ are eligible to receive the high dose flu shot at the Windsor Flu Shot Clinic. The Windsor Health Department will administer the standard dose flu shot and the Stop and Shop Pharmacy will be on-site to administer the high dose flu shot.

Both the high dose and standard dose flu shots are quadrivalent vaccines which means that they provide protection for 2 influenza A viruses and 2 influenza B viruses. The high dose flu shot contains four times the amount of antigen which is the ingredient that prompts the body to make antibodies creating a stronger immune response. This year the CDC has recommended that those 65yo+ receive the high dose influenza vaccine.

Insurance - Windsor Health Department

The Windsor Health Department is a provider for the following insurances: Medicare, Medicare Aetna, Medicare Anthem BC/BS, Medicare Cigna, Medicare Connecticare and Medicare United Healthcare.

Since WHD is **not a Husky (Medicaid) Provider**, persons with Husky Insurance can either pay the \$30 fee or choose a place to get vaccinated where they accept Husky Insurance. The fee for a standard dose quadrivalent flu shot \$30 (cash or check only) if there is no insurance coverage.

Insurance – Stop and Shop Pharmacy

Stop and Shop is a provider for Medicare and Medicaid and many other insurances. The fee for a high dose quadrivalent flu shot is \$100 (cash or check only) if there is no insurance coverage.

Consent forms will be available at the clinic or may be obtained at the Senior Center at LP Wilson Community Center prior to the clinic. Persons are expected to wear a mask at the clinic as it is considered a health care setting when shots are being administered.
