

## Town of Windsor Mask Policy – Updated 3-1-2022



Based on new CDC and State of CT COVID-19 safety protocols regarding use of face masks/face coverings, the following policy will be in place as of Wednesday, March 2, 2022 at 12:00am for Town of Windsor facilities and operations.

### **What does this mean for employees and patrons?**

- All town employees and patrons regardless of vaccination status will no longer be **required** to wear a mask throughout the town buildings. (*exceptions: Caring Connection, Discovery Center, Dial-A-Ride drivers and riders while on routes*)
- The plexiglass and other adjustments made in your departments will remain intact.

### **Expectations of Employees**

- If you are more comfortable wearing a mask...WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO DO SO!
- Please continue to wash your hands and use sanitizer.
- Continue to be respectful of each other's space.

### **Noteworthy Information**

- COVID-19 vaccines are effective at preventing COVID-19 disease, especially severe illness and death.
- COVID-19 vaccines reduce the risk of people spreading COVID-19. There is information showing it's unlikely a vaccinated person who becomes infected with the coronavirus transmits it to someone else.
- Please monitor your health and watch for symptoms. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, please contact the Health Department. If you are feeling sick, you should stay home and take care of yourself.
