# MEDICARE ADVANTAGE OPEN ENROLLMENT

You can make changes to your Medicare Advantage and Medicare drug coverage when certain events happen in your life, like if you move or you lose other coverage.

These chances to make changes are called Special Enrollment Periods.

The types of changes you can make and the timing depend on your life event.

If you have questions or need help making enrollment changes, call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227). TTY users can call 1-877-486-2048.

Starting Jan. 1, 2024, if you sign up for Part A and/or Part B because of an exceptional situation, you'll have 2 months to join a Medicare Advantage Plan (with or without drug coverage) or a Medicare drug plan (Part D). Your coverage will start the first day of the month after the plan gets your request to join.

If you're already in a Medicare Advantage Plan, **Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment Period** runs from January 1-March 31.This is the time you can switch to another Medicare Advantage Plan with or without drug coverage. You can also drop your Medicare Advantage Plan and go back to Original Medicare or join a Medicare drug plan.

#### ACCESS HEALTH CT OPEN ENROLLMENT

Open enrollment period for 2024 coverage thru Access Health CT is from November 1, 2023 thru January 15, 2024. Enroll by December 15th to have coverage starting January 1, 2024. For questions and application assistance, call 1-855-805-4325. Live chats are available at AccessHealthCT.com.
