GREATER HARTFORD LEGAL AID APPOINTMENTS AT LP WILSON

Greater Hartford Legal Aid is taking appointments at the Windsor Food Bank office at LP Wilson the **1st Friday of every month** between 9-11AM.

GHLA is a not-for-profit law firm providing **FREE**, high-quality legal services to address the most critical needs of low-income people. **FREE** statewide services include but aren't limited to matters relating to family, housing, children, employment, government, benefits, seniors and immigration.

GHLA will also be coming to the Windsor Senior Center the **last** Friday of every month and will take appointments for seniors only.

WIC- WOMEN, INFANTS & CHILDREN APPOINTMENTS AT LP WILSON

Harford WIC assists women with babies to purchase necessary nutritional food items and formula. Eligibility is based on household size, income, and assets. WIC is now offering appointments at the LP Wilson Community Center, AP1 Room, **the first Tuesday of each month** with appointments scheduled between 9AM-1PM. To schedule an appointment, call the WIC main line at 860-757-4780. In addition to the support that is being provided by Hartford WIC, the Social Service staff will continue to offer guidance to residents requiring extra support with food and basic needs for their families. Social Service staff will also continue to offer basic needs such as diapers, wipes, and food items through the Windsor Food and Fuel Bank

EVERSOURCE ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS

10% and 50% Discounts Available. On Dec. 1, 2023, Eversource introduced a new discount rate for electric customers with a financial hardship status. Based on household income or receipt of a public assistance benefit, customers may be eligible for a 10% or 50% discount off their electric bill per month.

RENTER'S REBATE PROGRAM

OPEN APRIL 1ST- SEPTEMBER 30TH
