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Letter from the Field Office Director

Thank you for requesting the CT HUD Office's local publication, "Looking for HUD Associated Housing in CT." This publication has been designed to make it easier for you to identify and apply for HUD-associated rental housing. Originally, this book was designed solely for that purpose. However, over time we have found that people often need additional housing supports and rental options. Accordingly, you will find a variety of related information including contact information for other agencies that may be able to help you locate housing. You may wish to call 2-1-1 or access their website at www.211ct.org/, to view their database of affordable housing . In addition, the State of Connecticut maintains a website of state-wide housing opportunities which can be found online at www.cthousingsearch.org.

Are you in danger of being evicted?

Are you facing homelessness?

If so, please call United Way/ 2-1-1 instead of contacting HUD directly. In Connecticut, dialing 2-1-1 is the first step to get support, as HUD Offices do not provide housing directly. Please start by calling 2-1-1, pressing option 3 and then pressing option 1. You will be directly connected to a housing specialist who will provide you with the current shelter options and create an appointment for you with the local Coordinated Access Network or CAN. Through working with the CAN, your housing needs will be assessed, and staff will help you identify housing opportunities to match your needs as quickly as possible.

- If you are **under the age of 18** and are facing homelessness, please call 2-1-1 and press option 1. A housing specialist will help you find shelter in Connecticut. You may also call your town or city hall to find out about local youth shelters in your area.
- If you are a **veteran** facing homelessness, please refer to page 14 in this book or call the National Homeless Veterans Hotline (24/7) at 1-877-424-3838.
- Persons subject to domestic violence can call the statewide Domestic Violence Hotline at 1-888-774-2900 and/or their local police by dialing or texting 911, if subject to imminent violence.
- Individuals whose unit is not habitable, due to fire, flood or other emergency, need to contact emergency personnel for assistance. We have found that 2-1-1, the Red Cross and Salvation Army can often temporarily house people in these situations.

Do you think you have been a victim of housing discrimination?

Federal law prohibits housing discrimination based on your race, color, national origin, religion, sex, family status, or disability. If you feel you are a victim of discrimination you may file a complaint with HUD

The State of CT has additional protected classes and prohibits housing discrimination based on race, color, national origin, sex, ancestry, religion, family status, presence of children, mental or physical disability, marital status, age, sexual orientation, legal source of income, gender identity or expression. These complaints must be filed with the state. For more details please see pages 10-11.

Housing issues can be complex. We have prepared this guide as a resource to assist you in your search and would appreciate suggestions for improvements to this publication. The Department is very interested in working with organizations to expand the supply of affordable housing and would welcome calls from such groups interested in HUD's programs. How to Use the Guidebook

- 1. Look up the town** where you may want to live. (Listings start on page 39)
- 2. Call the property agent or program** to ask about vacancies, eligibility, rents and application procedures. Property agents accept applications if the applicant can pay the rent and meet other requirements as listed in their tenant selection policy which is available upon request to any applicant. Apartments may have a rent subsidy to keep rents lower; the property agent can tell you if there is one available. Apartments with rent subsidy may have additional requirements. Generally, applicant(s) must:
 - (1) have an income at or below the maximum established income limit for the area,
 - (2) documents such as government photo ID, social security card, birth certificate, W-2 form, bank statement
 - (3) agree to pay the established rent.

Be advised that there may be long waiting lists at many properties, so you'll want to apply to as many places as possible.
- 3. Know your rights and responsibilities:** Federal law prohibits housing discrimination based on your race, color, national origin, religion, sex, family status, or disability. If you have been trying to rent a home or apartment and you believe your rights have been violated, you can file a fair housing complaint (pages 10-11). When you live in an apartment, you have both rights and responsibilities. Be sure you understand what's expected of you - and what you can expect in return.
- 4. Housing Counseling:** HUD funds housing counseling agencies throughout the country that can give you advice on buying, renting, defaults, foreclosures and reverse mortgages. Things You Should Know

- **HUD does NOT own or manage housing, nor does it take applications for housing.**
- **Public Housing** is low-income housing, operated by your local housing authority

- The **Housing Choice Voucher Program** (Section 8) allows you to find your own unit using the voucher to pay for all or part of the rent. To apply contact your local housing authority (page 38).

Completing the Application

When you complete a rental application, you must include the following information plus any additional information required by the program for which you're applying.

Always request a copy of any forms you sign in when applying to a new unit or re-certifying.



Income

- All sources of money you or any member of your household receives (wages, welfare payments, alimony, social security, pension, etc.); including the names of all of the people (adults and children) who will be living with you, whether or not they are related to you.
- Any money you receive on behalf of your children (child support, social security for children, etc.);
- Income from assets (interest from a savings account, credit union, or certificate of deposit, dividends from stock, etc.);
- Earnings from second job or part time job;
- Any anticipated income (such as a bonus or pay raise you expect to receive).

Assets

- All bank accounts, savings bonds, certificates of deposit, stocks, real estate, etc. that are owned by you and any adult member of your family's household who will be living with you.
- Any business or asset you sold in the last 2 years for less than its full value, such as your home to your children.

Signing the Application

- Do not sign any form unless you have read it, understand it, and are sure everything is complete and accurate.
- When you sign the application and certification forms, you are claiming that they are complete to the best of your knowledge and belief. You are committing fraud if you sign a form knowing that it contains false or misleading information.
- Information you provide on your application will be verified including and not limited to computer matches of the income you report with various Federal, State, or private agencies.



Recertification

- You must provide updated information as required. Some programs require that you report any changes in income or family/household composition immediately. Be sure to ask when you must recertify and what you must report on recertification forms.
- All income changes, such as increases and decreases of pay and/or benefits, change or loss of job and/or benefits, etc., for all household members must be reported as noted in your lease.
- Any move in or out of a household member
- All assets that you or your household members own and any assets that were sold in the last two years.

Beware of Fraud - You should be aware of the following fraud schemes:

- Do not pay any money to file an application;
- Do not pay any money to move up on the waiting list;
- Do not pay for anything not covered by your lease;
- Get a receipt for any payments and,
- Get a written explanation if you are required to pay for anything other than rent (such as maintenance charges).



IMPORTANT

Penalties for Committing Fraud

HUD places a high priority on preventing fraud. If your application or recertification forms contain false or incomplete information, you may be:

- ⇒ Evicted from your apartment or house;
- ⇒ Required to repay all overpaid rental assistance you received;
- ⇒ Fined;
- ⇒ Prohibited from receiving future assistance.

Section 8

The number of Section 8 vouchers is limited by federal funding. They are obtained by applying to individual housing authorities or the State of CT Department of Housing (through their contractor J.D'Amelia & Associates). All of these sources, however, have waiting lists, many of which are quite long. Most of the time, waiting lists are "closed," that is, they do not accept new applicants. Occasionally, however, a housing authority or the state will open its waiting list, usually for a fixed period of time, to accept new applications. Such openings are usually for two weeks or less and sometimes for as little as a single day. By state law, housing authorities must give at least two weeks' advance notice before a waiting list is opened. It is important to be aware of these notices and also to carefully follow each housing authority's directions for submitting an application.

- You can also register to receive electronic notice of the opening of Housing Choice Voucher waiting lists whenever they occur at www.cthcvp.org/
- Voucher holders find their own apartments and negotiate their own rents and leases with landlords. The landlord then signs an agreement with the housing authority that is administering the voucher. Each month, voucher holders pay their share of the rent (approximately 30% of income) to the landlord, and the housing authority pays the balance of the rent directly to the landlord.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a Section 8 voucher, a household's income must usually be less than 50% of the median income in the area, based on family size. The exact limits vary from area to area. There are also special categories of applicants for whom the income limit may be higher. Check with the housing authority to which you are applying to find out what its income limits are by voucher type.

Income Limits

HUD sets income limits that determine eligibility for assisted housing programs including the Public Housing, Section 8 project-based, Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher, Section 202 housing for the elderly, and Section 811 housing for persons with disabilities programs. If I get a Section 8 voucher in a particular town, do I have to move there?

Section 8 vouchers are "portable," which means that you can use them anywhere in Connecticut. In fact, you can use them anywhere in the United States. Local housing authorities, however, are allowed to put some limits on the portability of vouchers. The most important limit is that if you get a voucher from a town in which you are not presently living, the housing authority has the ability to require you to use your voucher only in that town for the first year that you have the voucher (after that you can move anywhere). Not all towns, however, impose this requirement. To find out if there is such a requirement, you must contact the local housing authority.

Discrimination

HUD's Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity (FHEO) works to eliminate housing discrimination, promote economic opportunity, and achieve diverse, inclusive communities. Federal law prohibits housing discrimination based on your race, color, national origin, religion, sex, family status, or disability.

Connecticut law prohibits discrimination based on "source of income." State law applies to all housing except certain owner-occupied buildings. In CT, if the rent for the apartment is within Section 8 limits, you cannot be rejected because you will be paying with a Section 8 voucher.

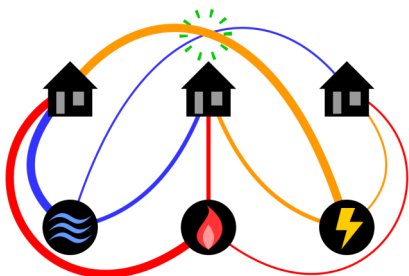

Reporting Fraud

Abuse of HUD programs should be reported to HUD's Office of Inspector General (OIG) Hotline using one of three options below:

You must submit a statement in support of allegations of fraud, waste, abuse, and/or mismanagement. Information that is too vague or cannot be supported can result in a closed report, without any action taken.

Healthcare for Homeless Veterans

VA Connecticut's Healthcare for Homeless Veterans (HCHV) Program encompasses an array of services and service links for Veterans who are homeless, at risk of homelessness, under housed, or economically challenged. These services range from emergency shelter housing to transitional housing, to permanent supportive housing and HUD-VASH rental housing vouchers with clinical case management. The hallmark of these services is individually designed, intensive case management that allows the VA Homeless team to support our Veterans to meet not only their immediate housing needs, but also to pursue permanent housing.

The VA CT Homeless Program is made available to all Veterans, primarily through walk-in, National Homeless Veterans Hotline or direct referral. Homeless program staff outreach and engage Veterans who, if not currently engaged in VA services, can gain access to the full array of services offered by VA Connecticut. The Homeless team staff provides case management as well as supports for needy Veterans seeking basic needs, emergency shelter beds, transitional housing, and permanent housing.

HCHV Program Eligibility:

In general, eligibility for most Veterans' benefits is based on discharge from active military duty with honorable or other than dishonorable conditions. Some services may be available for Veterans who are ineligible for VA Healthcare. To gain access to HCHV services, Veterans must be:

1. Homeless or at risk of homelessness
2. Assessed and evaluated through outreach and intake with a HOMES Assessment interview
3. Meet income guidelines established by the Department of Veterans Affairs (for some services)

Esta publicación ha sido diseñada para facilitarle la identificación y solicitud de viviendas de alquiler asociadas con el HUD.

Originalmente, este libro fue diseñado solo con ese fin. Sin embargo, con el tiempo hemos descubierto que las personas suelen necesitar apoyo adicional para las soluciones de vivienda y opciones de alquiler. Por esta razón, encontrará una gran variedad de información relacionada, incluida la información de contacto de otras agencias que pueden ayudarle a encontrar su vivienda. Puede llamar al 2-1-1 o acceder al sitio web www.211ct.org/ para ver su base de datos de viviendas asequibles. Además, el estado de Connecticut mantiene un sitio web de oportunidades de vivienda en todo el estado que se puede encontrar en línea en www.cthousingsearch.org.

¿Se enfrenta a la falta de vivienda?

Si es así, llame a United Way/2-1-1 en lugar de comunicarse directamente con el HUD. En Connecticut, marcar el 2-1-1 es el primer paso para obtener apoyo, ya que las oficinas del HUD no brindan alojamiento de forma directa. Primero, llame al 2-1-1, pulse la opción 3 y luego la opción 1. Se le comunicará directamente con un especialista en vivienda que le brindará las opciones de alojamiento actuales y programará una cita para usted con la Red de Acceso Coordinado local (Coordinated Access Network, CAN). Mediante el trabajo conjunto con la red CAN, se evaluarán sus necesidades de vivienda y el personal lo ayudará a identificar oportunidades que se ajusten a sus necesidades lo más rápido posible.

- Si eres **menor de 18 años** y te enfrentas a la falta de vivienda, llama al 2-1-1 y pulsa la opción 1. Un especialista en vivienda te ayudará a encontrar un lugar en Connecticut. También puedes llamar a tu ciudad o ayuntamiento para obtener información sobre los alojamientos para jóvenes locales en tu área.
- Si usted es **veterano de guerra** y se enfrenta a la falta de vivienda, consulte la página 25 de este libro o llame a la línea directa nacional para veteranos sin hogar, National Homeless Veterans (las 24 horas, los 7 días de la semana) al 1-877-424-3838.
- Las víctimas de violencia doméstica pueden llamar a la línea directa estatal de violencia doméstica al 1-888-774-2900 o a la policía local marcando o enviando un mensaje de texto al 911, si hay peligro de violencia inminente.
- Las personas cuya unidad no es habitable debido a un incendio, una inundación u otra emergencia, deben comunicarse con el personal de emergencias para recibir ayuda. Hemos sabido que, a menudo, el 2-1-1, la Cruz Roja y el Ejército de Salvación pueden albergar temporalmente a personas en estas situaciones.

¿Cree que ha sido víctima de discriminación en la vivienda?

La legislación federal prohíbe la discriminación en materia de vivienda basada en cuestiones de raza, color, nacionalidad religión, sexo, situación familiar o discapacidad. Si cree que es víctima de discriminación, puede presentar una queja ante el HUD

Cómo usar esta Guía

1. Busque la ciudad donde le gustaría vivir. (el listado comienza en la página 39)

2. Llame al agente inmobiliario o al programa para preguntarle sobre vacantes, elegibilidad, alquileres y procedimientos de solicitud. Los agentes inmobiliarios aceptan solicitudes si el solicitante puede pagar el alquiler y cumplir con otros requisitos que se enumeran en su política de selección de inquilinos, disponible a pedido de cualquier solicitante. Los pisos pueden tener un subsidio de alquiler para mantener los alquileres más bajos; el agente inmobiliario puede decirle si hay uno disponible. Los pisos con subsidio de alquiler pueden tener requisitos adicionales. En general, los solicitantes deben:

- (1) tener un ingreso igual o inferior al límite máximo de ingresos establecido para el área,
- (2) contar con documentos tales como identificación con foto emitida por el gobierno, tarjeta de seguro social, certificado de nacimiento, formulario W-2, resumen bancario
- (3) aceptar pagar el alquiler establecido.

Tenga en cuenta que puede haber largas listas de espera en muchas propiedades, por lo que debería presentar su solicitud en el mayor número de lugares posible.

3. Conozca sus derechos y responsabilidades: La legislación federal prohíbe la discriminación en materia de vivienda basada en cuestiones de raza, color, nacionalidad religión, sexo, situación familiar o discapacidad. Si ha estado tratando de alquilar una casa o piso y cree que se han vulnerado sus derechos, puede presentar una queja en materia de vivienda justa (página 21). Cuando se vive en un piso, tiene diferentes derechos y responsabilidades. Asegúrese de comprender lo que se espera de usted y lo que puede esperar a cambio.

4. Asesoría de Vivienda: El HUD financia agencias de asesoría de vivienda en todo el país que pueden brindarle asesoramiento sobre la compra, el alquiler, los incumplimientos de pago, las ejecuciones hipotecarias y las hipotecas inversas. Lo que debe saber

- **El HUD NO posee ni administra viviendas, ni acepta solicitudes de vivienda.** El programa de **vivienda pública** (Public Housing) consiste en alojamiento para personas con ingresos bajos, operado por su autoridad de vivienda local

- El **Programa de Cupones de Oportunidad para la Vivienda** (Housing Choice Voucher Program) (Sección 8) le permite encontrar su propia unidad utilizando el cupón para pagar la totalidad o parte del alquiler. Para presentar una solicitud, comuníquese con la autoridad de vivienda local (página 38).

Completar la solicitud

Cuando complete una solicitud de alquiler, debe incluir la siguiente información además de cualquier dato que sea requerido por el programa para el que está realizando la solicitud.

Pida siempre una copia de todos los formularios que firme cuando solicite una nueva unidad o recertifique.



Ingresos

- Todas las fuentes de ingresos que usted o cualquier miembro de su hogar recibe (salarios, pagos de asistencia social, pensión alimenticia, seguridad social, pensión, etc.); incluidos los nombres de todas las personas (adultos y niños) que vivan con usted, sean o no familiares suyos.
- Cualquier dinero que recibe en nombre de sus hijos (cuota alimentaria/manutención infantil, seguridad social para niños, etc.);
- Ingresos provenientes de activos (intereses de una cuenta de ahorros, cooperativa de crédito o certificado de depósito, dividendos de acciones, etc.);
- Ingresos de un segundo trabajo o trabajo a tiempo parcial;
- Cualquier ingreso anticipado (como un bono o un aumento de sueldo que espera recibir).

Activos

- Todas las cuentas bancarias, bonos de ahorro, certificados de depósito, acciones, bienes raíces, etc. que sean de su propiedad y de cualquier miembro adulto del hogar que viva con usted.
- Cualquier negocio o activo que haya vendido en los últimos 2 años por menos de su valor total, como la casa para sus hijos.

Firma de la solicitud

- No firme ningún formulario, a menos que lo haya leído, entendido, y esté seguro de que todo esté completo y que la información sea exacta.
- Cuando firma los formularios de solicitud y certificación, usted afirma que están completos a su leal saber y entender. Si firma un formulario sabiendo que contiene información falsa o engañosa cometerá el delito de fraude.
- La información que proporcione en la solicitud se verificará, incluidas, entre otras, las coincidencias por computadora de los ingresos que informe con varias agencias federales, estatales o privadas.



Recertificación

- Debe proporcionar cierta información actualizada, según sea necesario. Algunos programas requieren que informe cualquier cambio en los ingresos o en la composición de la familia/hogar de inmediato. Asegúrese de preguntar cuándo debe volver a certificar la información y qué debe incluir en los formularios correspondientes.
- Todos los cambios de ingresos, como aumentos y disminuciones de pago o beneficios, cambio o pérdida de trabajo o beneficios, etc., para todos los miembros del hogar deben informarse como se indica en su contrato de arrendamiento.
- Cualquier mudanza de un miembro del hogar
- Todos los activos que usted o los miembros de su hogar poseen y cualquier activo que se haya vendido en los últimos dos años.

Tenga cuidado con el fraude: debe tener en cuenta los siguientes esquemas de fraude:

- No pague por presentar una solicitud;
- No pague para tener mayor prioridad en la lista de espera;
- No pague por nada que no esté cubierto por su contrato de arrendamiento;
- Obtenga un recibo de todos los pagos y,
- Solicite una explicación por escrito si debe pagar algo que no sea el alquiler (como los cargos de mantenimiento).



IMPORTANTE

Sanciones por cometer fraude

El HUD se esfuerza por evitar situaciones de fraude. Si incluye información falsa o incompleta en los formularios de solicitud o recertificación, es posible que:

- ⇒ Sea desalojado del piso o casa;
- ⇒ Se requiera que pague toda la asistencia de alquiler pagada en exceso que recibió;
- ⇒ Sea multado;
- ⇒ Reciba una prohibición de recibir asistencia futura.

Sección 8

La cantidad de cupones de la Sección 8 está limitada por los fondos federales. Estos se obtienen mediante solicitud a las autoridades de vivienda individuales o al Departamento de Vivienda del Estado de CT (a través de su contratista J.D'Amelia & Associates). Sin embargo, todas estas fuentes tienen listas de espera, muchas de las cuales son bastante largas. La mayoría de las veces, las listas de espera están «cerradas», es decir, no aceptan nuevos solicitantes. Ocasionalmente, sin embargo, una autoridad de vivienda o el estado abrirá la lista de espera, generalmente por un período fijo, para aceptar nuevas solicitudes. Estas aperturas suelen ser por dos semanas o menos y, a veces, por solo un día. En virtud de la ley estatal, las autoridades de vivienda deben avisar con al menos dos semanas de anticipación antes de que se abra una lista de espera. Es importante estar al tanto de estos avisos y también seguir cuidadosamente las instrucciones de cada autoridad de vivienda para presentar una solicitud.

- También puede registrarse para recibir un aviso electrónico de la apertura de las listas de espera de Cupones de Oportunidad para la Vivienda siempre que ocurran en www.cthevp.org/
- Los titulares de cupones encuentran sus propios pisos y negocian sus propios alquileres y contratos de arrendamiento con los propietarios. Luego, el propietario firma un acuerdo con la autoridad de vivienda que administra el cupón. Cada mes, los titulares de cupones pagan su parte del alquiler (aproximadamente el 30 % de los ingresos) al arrendador, y la autoridad de vivienda paga el saldo del alquiler directamente al arrendador.

Elegibilidad

Para ser elegible para un cupón de la Sección 8, el ingreso de un hogar generalmente debe ser inferior al 50 % del ingreso medio en el área, según el tamaño de la familia. Los límites exactos varían de un área a otra. También existen categorías especiales de solicitantes para quienes el límite de ingresos puede ser mayor. Consulte con la autoridad de vivienda a la que se está postulando para averiguar cuáles son sus límites de ingresos por tipo de cupón.

Límites de ingresos

El HUD establece límites de ingresos que determinan la elegibilidad para los programas de vivienda asistida, incluidos los programas de Vivienda Pública (Public Housing), basado en proyectos de la Sección 8, Cupón de Oportunidad para la Vivienda (Housing Choice Voucher) de la Sección 8, vivienda de la Sección 202 para personas mayores y vivienda de la Sección 811 para personas con discapacidades.

Si obtengo un cupón de la Sección 8 en una ciudad en particular, ¿tengo que mudarme allí?

Los cupones de la Sección 8 son «portátiles», lo que significa que puede usarlos en cualquier parte de Connecticut. De hecho, puede usarlos en cualquier parte de los Estados Unidos. Sin embargo, las autoridades locales de vivienda pueden poner algunos límites a la portabilidad de los cupones. El límite más importante es que si obtiene un cupón de una ciudad en la que no vive actualmente, la autoridad de vivienda tiene la capacidad de exigirle que use su cupón solo en esa ciudad durante el primer año que lo tenga (después de eso, se puede mudar a cualquier parte). Sin embargo, no todas las localidades imponen este requisito. Para averiguar si existe tal requisito, debe comunicarse con la autoridad de vivienda local.

Discriminación

La Oficina de Vivienda Justa e Igualdad de Oportunidades (Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity, FHEO) del HUD trabaja para eliminar la discriminación en la vivienda, promover oportunidades económicas y lograr comunidades diversas e inclusivas. La legislación federal prohíbe la discriminación en cuestiones de vivienda basada en la raza, color, nacionalidad religión, sexo, situación familiar o discapacidad.

La legislación de Connecticut prohíbe la discriminación basada en la «fuente de ingresos». La ley estatal se aplica a todas las viviendas, excepto a ciertos edificios ocupados por sus propietarios. En CT, si el alquiler del piso está dentro de los límites de la Sección 8, no puede ser rechazado porque se vaya a pagar con un cupón de dicha sección.

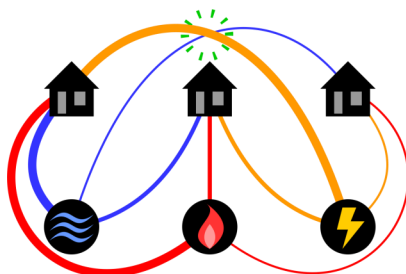

Atención médica para veteranos sin hogar

El Programa Healthcare for Homeless Veterans (HCHV) VA de Connecticut abarca una gran variedad de servicios y enlaces de servicios para veteranos sin hogar, en riesgo de quedarse sin hogar, con poca vivienda o con dificultades económicas. Estos servicios comprenden desde viviendas de refugio de emergencia hasta viviendas de transición, viviendas de apoyo permanente y cupones de vivienda de alquiler HUD-VASH con administración de casos clínicos. El sello distintivo de estos servicios es el manejo intensivo de casos diseñado individualmente que permite que el equipo de VA para personas sin hogar apoye a nuestros veteranos para satisfacer no solo sus necesidades inmediatas de vivienda, sino también para buscar una vivienda permanente.

El programa VA de CT para personas sin hogar está disponible para todos los veteranos, principalmente a través de la línea directa nacional para veteranos sin hogar o referencia directa. El personal del programa para personas sin hogar se comunica e involucra a los veteranos que, si no están actualmente involucrados en los servicios de VA, pueden obtener acceso a la gama completa de servicios que ofrece VA de Connecticut. El personal del equipo para personas sin hogar brinda administración de casos, así como apoyo para veteranos necesitados que requieren satisfacer necesidades básicas, camas de refugio de emergencia, vivienda de transición y vivienda permanente.

Elegibilidad del programa HCHV:

En general, la elegibilidad para la mayoría de los beneficios de los veteranos se basa en la baja del servicio militar activo con condiciones honorables o no deshonrosas. Algunos servicios pueden estar disponibles para veteranos que no son elegibles para VA Healthcare. Para obtener acceso a los servicios de HCHV, los veteranos deben:

1. Ser personas sin hogar o en riesgo de serlo;
2. Ser contemplados y evaluados a través de la divulgación y la admisión con una entrevista de evaluación de HOMES;
3. Cumplir con las pautas de ingresos establecidas por el Departamento de Asuntos de Veteranos (en el caso de algunos servicios).

Homeless Programs / Programas para Personas sin Hogar

In accordance with federal regulations, partners across Connecticut worked collaboratively to develop and implement a coordinated system that provides individuals and families experiencing homelessness with streamlined access to services. The statewide coordinated access system divides the state into seven Coordinated Access Networks (CANs) of community partners that work together to identify and serve households experiencing homelessness in their regions. Our system uses 2-1-1 as the universal front entry to homeless assistance.

The housing specialist will discuss your current situation and help to identify potential resources to assist (such as utility assistance, childcare, food resources, crisis intervention). If you need immediate shelter or additional homeless assistance, the housing specialist will connect you to your regional Coordinated Access Network.

De acuerdo con las regulaciones federales, regiones de todo a través de Connecticut han estado trabajando conjuntamente para desarrollar e implementar un sistema que puede proporcionar servicios a todas las personas sin vivienda.
